
9 – **FYI** - **INSTALLING A T - P ROLL BRAKE**. Yes, I know laugh if you feel the need to. Have you ever spent the day traveling the highways and byways then walked back to the bathroom to find a whole roll of T - P unrolled and neatly folded on the floor, we have experienced the above problem four times in as many months of owning this coach. How do you secure the toilet paper on the Tiffin installed roll holder yet also

have the roll ready for instant one handed use. After some thinking and asking Cathey a few questions, we made a trip to the local Dollar Tree store. For the grand total of \$ 1.00 plus tax we

purchased what I will call two toilet paper roll brakes, which will take care of our two toilet bath and a half coach. The package contains a "Mini Paint Roller Set". The set comes with two three inch wide small yellow foam rollers with plastic inserts and two roller handles which were promptly thrown away.



The plastic inserts were carefully removed from the foam rolls a small amount of glue had been used to hold them to the inside of the foam roll.



After the inserts had been removed the foam roller was carefully slid over the T - P roll holder and centered on the holder.



A roll of toilet paper was slid in place on the holder, a small amount of friction holds the foam roller in place on the T - P roll holder and the foam is applying a small amount of friction on the roll of toilet paper keeping it from unrolling without at least one handed assistance.
