38 – FYI - EMERGENCY EGRESS WINDOW. Some months ago I prepared our coach for an emergency egress through the bedroom window. I purchased a 7/8 inch hard wood dowel from Lowe's, cut the dowel to 30 inches in length. One end of the dowel was cut at a 45 degree angle to make placing the dowel in the window's frame easier and faster in a short period of time, like in an emergency. The wood dowel is normally held in place and ready for an emergency by two garbage bag twist ties, I figure in an emergency I can grab the dowel lift up on it which will begin turning the two red handles as the dowel is removed. Continue turning the two red handles until the handles are vertical then push out on the bottom of the window. Insert the dowel between the bottom of the window and the bottom of the window frame to hold the window propped fully open. The dowel was cut long enough to hold the window open at a 90 degree angle to the coach.





Leaving the coach in this manner (emergency egress) is a one way trip as the distance is too high to easily climb back in without some form of assistance.
