THIRTY-NINTH - coach modification - INSTALLING A PANASONIC SOUND BAR FOR THE BEDROOM TV. Our bedroom TVs speakers are almost non-existent and they are mounted in the bottom of the TV pointing down toward the top of the wardrobe. The actual rated output power for the speakers is a joke.

Enter our most recent modification, the addition of a Panasonic SC-HTB10 Sound Bar. This modification required me to build two mounting brackets which were attached to the back of the sound bar with two M5 x 12 screws and lock washers. The mounting brackets were then screwed to the bottom of the TVs cabinet using two # 8 x 3/4 wood screws maintaining the same angle used by the TV.



One HDMI cable was used which allows **ONE** remote control for powering both TV and Sound Bar ON/OFF plus the sound bars volume control, and one digital optical cable for the TV audio output to the Sound Bar.
