FORTY-FORTH - coach modification, COACH COCKPIT CURTAIN. This latest coach modification is nothing very innovative and it is not permanent. We purchased a decorative 6 foot shower adjustable tension rod from Walmart for about \$10.00. To that we added a pair of brown 84 inch curtains additional cost of less than \$20.00. Both can be removed, easily stored and re-installed when needed. The tension rod was installed between the top rearward corners of the overhead cabinets mounted over the pilot and co-pilot seats, the cabinet doors can still be opened without any problem. The first photo show the curtains closed (pulled together) however with the slides open. This was an easy way to photograph the curtains. While driving the slides will both be retracted which will have both forward slide walls against the curtain. The pass though between the slides is the portion which we are interested in preventing the cold air or hot air moving past. We have not traveled to the frozen north or the blazing southwest but the cockpit has been comfortable with this low cost addition in place traveling the southeast using just the engine powered dash Air Conditioning or dash heat.
