SIXTY-SECOND - coach modification – <u>PILOT 12VDC AND 120 VAC</u> <u>OUTLETS</u>. On our coach Tiffin installed a duplex 120 VAC outlet, a telephone outlet and 12 VDC outlet on the right side of the center drawer stack near the floor. Prior to this modification the laptop computer and navigation system were plugged into those outlets which meant the cords were routed over the top of the center console.

A 12 VDC socket and duplex 120 VAC outlet were added they are located near the floor behind the steering column. This modification allows the power cords for the laptop computer and navigation system to be moved off the top of the center console and routed near the floor or behind the dash. The OEM 120 VAC outlet is powered by the Entertainment circuit breaker in the sub-panel (part of the main circuit breaker panel) which is powered through the inverter. I connected the new 120 VAC outlet to the OEM outlet. The 12 VDC socket is connected and powered by the house batteries though a 10 Amp fuse, the fuse is located near the 12 VDC outlet.
